In the past the Village has tried to start a curbside recycling program with our waste hauler but the community did not want to pay the cost for the program. Although the cost was extremely low, it was rejected by a 10 to 1 margin. We do have recycling bins at the Public Works garage; however, it is not always open or convenient for our residents.

In an attempt to have some resemblance of a recycling program I have reached an agreement with Homewood Disposal to drop off a recycling container at the Senior Center one (1) Saturday a month at no-cost to the Village. Therefore, **beginning Saturday, August 29<sup>th</sup>** the recycling bin will be open **from 9:00 am to 12:00 noon** and will continue on the **last Saturday of the month, every month thereafter.**

The location will be the same each month; Senior Center at 3140 Enterprise Park, South Chicago Heights.

**RECYCLING CHART**

<u>What Gets Recycled</u>	<u>What is NOT Recycled</u>
<i>Newspaper</i> - Newspaper and newspaper inserts.	Please no soiled paper.
<i>Cardboard</i> - Empty all boxes and flatten.	Please no food contamination, wax coated boxes or packing material.
<i>Other Fibers</i> - Magazines, catalogs, computer paper, phone books, chipboard and junk mail.	Please no wax or foil coatings. No hard cover books.
<i>Plastic Bottles</i> - Only plastic bottles that have a # 1 or # 2 on the bottom can be recycled at this time. Rinse clean to avoid an odor problem. Labels can be left on.	Please no containers NOT marked # 1 or # 2. No plastic bags or oil containers.
<i>Glass Bottles &amp; Jars</i> - Deposit both clear and colored glass into recycle bin. Labels can be left on, but rinse out to avoid an odor problem.	Please no flat glass, light bulbs, mirrors, ceramics, Pyrex, drinking glasses, broken glass or unwashed bottles.
<i>Tin and Aluminum Cans</i> - Please rinse out to avoid an odor problem. Labels can be left on.	Please no aerosol cans, paint cans, or unwashed cans. No clothes hangers.
