DISCUSSION – HOME RULE STATUS AND CRIME FREE HOUSING: Mayor Matthews stated that the Village now has the Home Rule Status and that the board needs to discuss the Crime Free Housing ordinance. Mayor Matthews asked Attorney Warner to explain. Attorney Warner summarized some different issues regarding licensing the owner of the property versus licensing the actual property and fees associated with a business license. Mayor Matthews opened the discussion to the Board. Discussion ensued amongst the Board regarding the fees for the license, fees for owners with multiple properties, cost of the classes, inspection types associated with the crime free ordinance. The Mayor and the Board agreed the Village Administrator Martinez-Gomez would meet with directors to work on compiling data associated with granting an owner with a Crime Free License.
