

Measurable Goals

PUBLIC EDUCATION AND OUTREACH

A-1 Informational brochures were made available at the Village hall and on the Village web site.

During the next reporting cycle the Village will continue to make available information brochures.

A-6 The Village has included informational brochures and material on their web site.

During the next reporting cycle the Village will continue to provide water quality language on their web site.

PUBLIC PARTICIPATION/INVOLVEMENT

B-7 The Village has cooperated with Youth and Family Services – Bloom Township that provides man power to clean up road right of ways, ditches and streams.

During the next reporting period, the Village will encourage the same participation.

ILLICIT DISCHARGE DETENTION AND ELIMINATION

C-1 No update of the Village Storm Sewer Maps was required.

During the next reporting cycle, the Village will update storm sewer maps as required.

C-2 The Village obtained a model Illicit Discharge and Connection Ordinance and is in the process of editing it for Board action.

During the next reporting cycle, the Village will continue reviewing the Illicit Discharge and Connection ordinance and once passed enforce same.

C-7 The Village performed outfall and stream reconnaissance.

During the next reporting period, the Village shall continue stream reconnaissance.

CONSTRUCTION SITE RUNOFF CONTROL

D-1 The Village required all projects and developments of one acre or more to obtain IEPA (NOI) ILRIO Permits prior to any work commencing on site.

During the next reporting cycle, the Village will continue to require development to obtain IEPA (NOI) ILRIO Permits and MWRD Permits if required.

D-4 The Village constructed a new Public Safety Building. SaukView Elementary School addition was constructed.

During the next reporting period, the Village shall review and require each construction project to have a SWPPP and NOI if required and MWRD Permits if required.

D-6 The Village inspected all construction activities during this reporting period to assure the erosion control measures were in place and functioning.

During the next reporting cycle the Village will continue their inspections of all construction activities.

POST CONSTRUCTION RUNOFF CONTROL

E-2 The Village is enforcing the Cook County Water Shed Ordinance.

During the next reporting cycle, the Village will enforce the Cook County Water Shed Ordinance.

POLLUTION PREVENTION/GOOD HOUSEKEEPING

F-1 In May of 2015 the Village Public Works held a safety meeting after which educational material on storm water pollutant discharges was handed out and discussed with all employees present.

During the next reporting cycle, the Village will continue to involve the Public Works employees in active discussions on illicit discharges.

F-2 The Village has a street cleaning program in which the streets are cleaned twice a year.
